All documents submitted will also be self-attested by the bidder. • The bidder should have direct authorization from the OEM for selling and supporting the equipment offered for the entire term of the agreement and shall provide MAF from OEM. • The bidders who have been awarded projects by APSFL in the past 2 years but have failed to execute, are not eligible to bid for this tender. • Formats for Pre-Qualification Bid along with the required supporting documents for each of the criteria. • Proposals without necessary supporting documents or without meeting the prescribed qualification criteria will be treated as ineligible and will not be considered for further evaluation. • In case of Consortium, one of the members should expressly be designated as the Lead member and all correspondence should be through the Lead member only. • Only 2 members are allowed in the Consortium including the lead member.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In case of consortium bids, only lead bidder will interact with APSFL for all obligations/payment.• No change in consortium members i.e. addition or dropping of a member shall be permitted after the submission of the bid.• In case of bids where for the fulfillment of turnover & experience eligibility requirements, experience and turnover of parent company (for bidder or consortium partner) is being considered then the bidder and consortium partner (if any) shall submit a declaration cum an undertaking from its Parent company stating that it (The Parent Company) shall support and take responsibility to enable its subsidiary company (the bidder/consortium partner) to perform the contractual obligation.
