They will have to provide valid GST registration proof, incorporation certificate, or utility bill for business address. • The startup must demonstrate technical capability through: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A working Proof of Concept (PoC) or pilot demonstration. • Product brochure or technical datasheet of the drone platform. • In-house or third-party test logs or videos from trial runs (optional but preferred). • The startup must show efforts towards compliance with DGCA norms, including submission of any of the following:
